### **Service Leadership New Club Building Fondation de nouveaux clubs SLP**

1. Copie de la charte du nouveau club
2. **\$1,000 \$ seront donnés au compte administratif du club parrain**
3. **500 \$ seront donnés au compte administratif du nouveau club**
4. Au début de la deuxième année du nouveau club, la Fondation contribuera de 100 \$ pour chaque nouveau membre qui s'ajoutera au minimum de 15 lors de l'émission de la charte.

The Foundation partnered with the Winnipeg Kiwanis Club to provide two grants. The first was a \$500 [Youth Grant](#) for [Rossbrooke House](#) in Winnipeg.

Created in 1976 Rossbrook House is a neighbourhood drop-in centre, with a simple mission: “*No child who does not want to be alone, should ever have to be.*” In the decades since, it has become a safe place for children and youth to belong, play, learn and become...

It offers a constant alternative to the destructive environment of the streets by:

Keeping the doors open 365 days of the year and 24 hours every weekend & period of school holidays.

Recruiting its staff from the young people who come to the centre on a

- regular basis
- Driving participants safely home each evening

Today, over 1,000 children and youth ages 6-24 years come through the doors annually and up to 80 participants on a daily basis. Beyond being a safe place to be, Rossbrook has three alternative school programs, an afterschool homework club, young mom’s group, sports and recreational activities, Aboriginal cultural activities, leadership activities, a music program and a healthy kitchen program that provides daily meals to participants while teaching them about healthy eating and cooking.

The second \$500 grant was [Send a Child to Camp grant](#) for the [West Broadway Youth Organization](#).

West Broadway Youth Organization is a drop-in recreational and life skills program for youth ages 4 and up. They provide year round, free after-school & summer programming in a safe, fun and nurturing environment.
